The Swaziland Vulnerability Assessment Committee¹ (Swazi VAC), with considerable support from the Central Statistical Office, conducted a nationwide survey to analyse the linkages between HIV/AIDS, demography and livelihoods in rural Swaziland. The study began in June 2003 and was completed in March 2004. The process included data collection, data capture, cleaning, analysis and report writing during this period. Further analysis and report writing is recommended for interested stakeholders when considering the rich data set captured by the survey.
